2. A wood two-story residence, located at 9355 S. Gozzer Rd, near the City of Harrison, Kootenai County, State of Idaho, 83833.					
3. On 01-22-08 at approximately 2126 hours, I responded to the above residence in reference to a residential burglary report. Upon my arrival, I contacted V/RP-Jeffrey Delbert Crofts, who advised someone entered his unlocked residence sometime between 1430 hours and 2000 hours and stole the above listed items.					
Crofts advised he leaves the door to his garage open for his dogs so they can come inside and stay warm, and said he didn't lock the door going into the house from the garage. When he came home today, he found his belongings strewn around the house, and immediately noticed a Marlin rifle that he had in the kitchen was missing. He also discovered he was missing \$200 from his wallet, which was sitting on the kitchen counter, along with another \$100 in misc. change which had been in a glass 2 gallon jar in his bedroom. Also in the kitchen, he found a kitchen knife had been stabbed into the counter, with the point still in the counter and the knife standing straight up.

<p>In his bedroom, he discovered two Remington 700 rifles missing from next to his bed. Another Remington 760 which had been in a different bedroom had been removed, and carried into Crotts' bedroom. Crotts advised he is the caretaker for the house, and the house itself belongs to the Gilmore family. The 760 belongs to the Gilmore's, and was not taken. Several boxes of ammo of different calibers were also taken from the closet, ranging from .357, 8mm, .444, .45, .302, and .307. On the bed, an empty .357 Blazer box was found, along with a 8mm Mauser Winchester box which had the shells dumped out on the bed. The magazine from the 760 was removed and placed on the dresser in the bedroom. All the drawers and closets in the house were gone through, and clothes removed and strewn about.</p> <p>Crotts also discovered the suspect(s) had eaten some candy while at the residence, and stolen several pairs of his 10 year old son's underwear. In addition, he is missing bottles of Ibuprofen and misc. toiletries. The suspect(s) did leave behind several other guns which were lying around in plain view, along with tools, electronics, alcohol, and other high value items. One of the rooms contained a lot of high dollar collectibles which belong to the Gilmore's, which were also not touched.</p> <p>I collected the ammo boxes on the bed to be fumed for fingerprints. I dusted the 760 for latent fingerprints and lifted partial prints which I transferred to six print cards. Crotts advised he is working on trying to obtain the serial numbers for the guns and will contact the SD if he locates them. Crotts also said he contacted his nearest neighbor, who advised she saw a black four door passenger car coming up the driveway at approximately 1600 hours today. The neighbor was already asleep so I was unable to contact her to get her information or further specifics about the vehicle.</p> <p>I returned the fingerprint cards and ammo boxes to KCSD and booked them into evidence.</p> <p>At approximately 0029 hours I responded to PSB in reference to a report of M1-Debbie Lynn Gilmore being there and needing to talk to someone about her son and guns. I contacted Debbie, who advised she was concerned about her son doing a "Columbine." Debbie said she found out that the residence on Gozzer Rd had been broken into, and that a dark four door passenger car was seen in the area. Debbie advised her son, IL1-Brian Edward Gilmore drives a black 1998 Pontiac Grand Prix four door.</p> <p>Debbie said Brian has been acting very strange lately, [REDACTED]. He's been arrested for shoplifting twice in Spokane, and today she received a call that he had stolen some items from the hunting department of Sportsmans Warehouse and ran out when Security tried to apprehend him. They obtained his license plate and contacted CDA H.S. where Brian is supposed to be going to school, however he did not go to school today. Debbie said she learned Brian has not showed up to school for a while now. Debbie said Brian was supposed to be taking his finals this week so he could transfer to Bridge Academy on Monday. Brian has not taken any of his finals so far. Debbie said Brian hates school and is upset with kids at both Lake City H.S. and Cda H.S. Debbie said Brian was expelled from Lake City H.S. [REDACTED].</p> <p>[REDACTED]. Debbie said Brian has been picked on by kids at school, and hates what he calls the "whole society of the jock thing." Debbie advised Brian has not made any specific threats, but said he doesn't talk to her, and when she took him to counseling it was unsuccessful because he wouldn't talk. She also said Brian's behavior lately has been very erratic, and his nose is always bleeding for unknown reasons.</p>

Debbie said lately, Brian has been doing a lot of research on the internet about guns and making silencers. She said he's always been very "military," and she recently discovered black "stealth" gloves in his room which she didn't buy for him. She said he's also been doing a lot of stuff on Craigslist, and somehow has lots of money for someone who only works for the church a couple of hours a week at \$6/hr. She said he also has two locked safes in his vehicle, which he won't let her see. Debbie said she was planning on taking the vehicle away from Brian if she locates it and will put it in storage until she can get into the safes. Debbie advised the vehicle belongs to her, and law enforcement has her permission to search it and all containers in it completely.

Debbie said when she learned of the burglary and the guns stolen, she believed her son might have been involved, partly due to the theft today, and because of the way he has been acting. She also noted that the only items stolen belonged to Crotts, and nothing was stolen that belonged to the Gilmore's. She said Brian would have known that there were lots of guns at the residence and that they were easily accessible.

Debbie said when Brian left the house this morning he was wearing all camouflage and didn't advise where he was going. Debbie said she talked to him this morning, and he hung up on her. Debbie said in this conversation, she told him that he was her "best guy," and he said no, he wasn't anymore, and that Debbie's new infant was the main guy in her life now. Debbie said she has tried calling Brian repeatedly since then, but he has not answered the phone. I also attempted to call the phone, and it went straight to voicemail.

Debbie said she does not know of any friends that Brian has, and couldn't think of any place he might go, other than into the woods somewhere. An attempt to locate was aired to surrounding agencies, and deputies checked various wooded locations and parks, as well as motels, however were unable to locate Brian's vehicle.

CDAPD was present during my conversation with Debbie, and all the above information was given to them in regards to the school issues.
